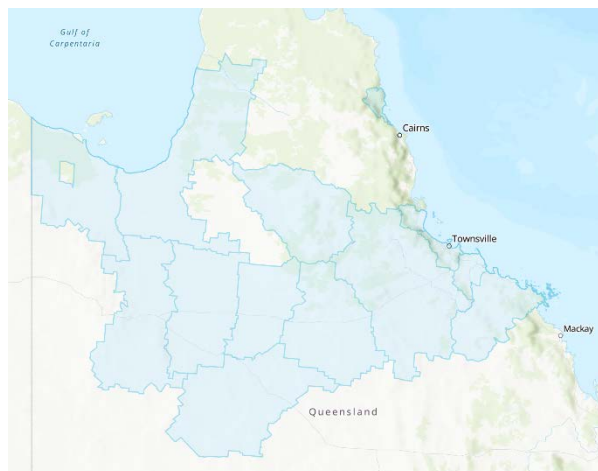


Image showing the North and Far North Queensland 2019 Monsoon Trough Flood Affected LGAs Boundaries
