
## Overview

### Top 100 assets in total SMSFs



### Growth in total assets over 5 and 10 years


The Top 100 SMSFs in 2023–24 grew their total assets by **84%** over the last 5 years and **358%** over the last 10 years. The median assets held by the top 100 SMSFs were **\$94m** in 2023–24.

(at 30 June 2024)


**59%** of the Top 100 SMSFs existed when the ATO became regulator in 1999.

#### Proportion of top 100 SMSFs by number of members


There are 245 members in the top 100 SMSFs, with **66%** of SMSFs in full or part retirement phase.

(at 30 June 2024)




### Proportion of top 100 SMSFs by asset range


### Top 100 SMSF benefit payments

The median income stream payment in 2023–24 was **\$300k** and the median lump sum was **\$2.1m**. **78** of the top 100 SMSFs paid a benefit payment to **196** members in 2023–24.



### Top 100 SMSF contributions


The median total contributions in 2023–24 were **\$51k**.




## Members
