




Members by gender 2021-22


Over **1.1 million** SMSF members

SMSF members in pension phase




A higher proportion of **males than females** aged **75+**

SMSF member balances




Over the 5 years to June 2022, **female average member balances** increased by **23%** to **\$736,000** while **male average member balances** increased by **19%** to **\$867,000**




Contributions to SMSFs for male and female members



From 2020-21 to 2021-22 average **member contributions** increased to:
\$48,800 or by **23%** for **females**
\$45,000 or by **21%** for **males**



At 30 June 2022, **males** had higher average SMSF **member balances** than **females** across all age groups



From 2020-21 to 2021-22 average **employer contributions** increased to:
\$11,600 or by **3%** for **females**
\$14,900 or by **4%** for **males**
