flexible and efficient.





Percentage of child support cases by collection method,









The majority (around two-thirds) of payees have care of their child support child for more than 313 nights a year, whereas the majority (around two-thirds) of payers have care for less than 52 nights a year. Over 13% of child support parents have shared care arrangements. The number of parents with a shared care arrangement who use rivate Collect is around double that of parents who use Agency Collect.





n the June quarter 2022, the median adjusted taxable income for payers in Private Collect cases is around \$13,200 higher than for payers in Agency Collect cases. For the same quarter, the median adjusted taxable income for payees in Private Collect cases is around \$800 higher than for payees in








In the June quarter 2022, more than 145,000 cases were assessed at the Minimum Annual Rate, which equates to around \$8.80 per week, Almost 65% of these were agency cases. The proportion of all cases that were assessed at the Minimal Annual Rate has reduced from around 23% in the June 2018 quarter to around 22% in the une 2022 quarter.






