



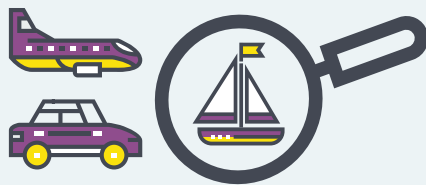
HOW PPSR STATISTICS RECORD AND REPORT TRANSACTIONS



TOTAL SEARCHES

The total number of searches on the PPSR can be calculated as the total searches by:

Search Type
OR
Type of User



TOTAL SEARCHES BY SEARCH TYPE

This is the total searches conducted on:

- Serial number (motor vehicle, watercraft, aircraft and intellectual property)
- Individual grantor
- Organisational grantor
- PPSR registration number
- Other searches

OR



TOTAL SEARCHES BY TYPE OF USER

This is the total searches conducted by:

- Internal user (National Service Centre)
 - External user
 - (Casual user and Account user)
- OR**
- B2G customer and Web UI customer



TOTAL TRANSACTIONS

Total transactions show the activity regarding PPSR registrations. The total transactions equals the total activities to:

- Create registrations
- Amend registrations
- Discharge/remove registrations



TOTAL TRANSACTIONS TO CREATE REGISTRATIONS

Transactions to create PPSR registrations on the register. When a registration on the PPSR has been created, this is recorded as a transaction.

AND



TOTAL TRANSACTIONS TO AMEND REGISTRATIONS

Transactions to amend current PPSR registrations on the register. When a registration has been amended or changed, this is recorded as a transaction.

AND



TOTAL TRANSACTIONS TO DISCHARGE/REMOVE REGISTRATIONS

Total transactions to discharge or remove current PPSR registrations from the register. When a registration has been discharged or removed, this is recorded as a transaction.



TOTAL EXPIRED/ REMOVED REGISTRATIONS

This amounts to PPSR registrations which are no longer current on the register.



TOTAL CURRENT REGISTRATIONS

This amounts to the total number of current active PPSR registrations on the register.



TOTAL CURRENT REGISTRATIONS

A registration is current if it has an end date in the future and has not expired or been removed.



COLLATERAL

Collateral is a personal property that has a security interest attached to it.

COLLATERAL TYPE



CONSUMER PROPERTY

A personal property held by an individual and not for any use in a business with an ABN.



COMMERCIAL PROPERTY

A personal property that is held in the course or furtherance, to any degree, of carrying on an enterprise or business to which an ABN has been allocated.



UNKNOWN COLLATERAL TYPE

Some migrated registrations record the collateral type as 'unknown' because they migrated from other registers that did not record this information.

OR

COLLATERAL CLASS

A registration on the PPSR requires the selection of a general description of the property covered by the registration.



AGRICULTURE

Personal property that is crops and livestock. A registration may be made against crops or livestock or against agriculture to cover both.



AIRCRAFT

Comprised of aircraft engine, airframe, helicopter and small aircraft. An aircraft must be described by serial number.



ALLPAAP

A security interest in all personal property that the grantor has an interest in at the time of registration, as well as a property acquired by the grantor after the registration is made.



ALLPAAP EXCEPT

This collateral class is the same as ALLPAAP with the exception of any property described in the free text field. A description of the property that is not subject to the security interest is mandatory.



FINANCIAL PROPERTY

Comprised of chattel paper, currency, document of title, intermediated security, investment instrument and negotiable instrument.



INTANGIBLE PROPERTY

Any property that is not tangible or financial property. It is made up of the sub-classes account, intellectual property, and general intangible.



MOTOR VEHICLE

Any vehicle:

- with a unique serial number such as a vehicle identification number (VIN), chassis number, manufacturer's number

OR

- equipment that is equipped with wheels to be attached or towed and has a unique serial number.



WATERCRAFT

A boat or vessel (other than a seaplane) with a hull identification number (HIN) or an official number.



OTHER GOODS

Other goods may be selected as a collateral class to describe all other tangible property that cannot be described by the above collateral classes. This may include art, machinery, or an outboard motor.

KIND OF INTEREST

Registrations of a security interest by registration kind are grouped together from the 3 categories to the right.

BEFORE
30TH JAN
2012

TRANSITIONAL

A transitional security interest (TSI) is an interest in personal property that secures payment or performance of an obligation which existed prior to 30 January 2012.

AFTER
30TH JAN
2012

NON-TRANSITIONAL

A non-transitional security interest is an interest in personal property that secures payment or performance of an obligation which existed after 30 January 2012.

PRESCRIBED
PROPERTY

PRESCRIBED PROPERTY

A prescribed property relates to the registrations on the PPSR for the following registration kind:

- Proceeds of crime
- Hoon liens
- Court Orders
- Other prescribed property under the PPS Act.
