Getting Started

1. Purpose

This document is to provide guidance for the Banned and Disqualified Organisations Dataset files uploaded infrequently to data.gov.au by ASIC.

2. Banned and Disqualified Organisations Dataset

The Banned and Disqualified Organisations Dataset file on data.gov.au is extracted from ASIC's Banned and Disqualified Registers. This dataset is a point in time snapshot of the Banned and Disqualified Organisations Register data.

The dataset provides information on organisations that are:

- banned from engaging in credit activities by a State or Territory
- banned or disqualified from providing financial services, and
- banned or disqualified from engaging in credit activities.

Some of the listed organisations may no longer be registered with ASIC and would be listed as deregistered companies.

The Banned and Disqualified Organisations Dataset contains publicly available information. See the data dictionary for fields available in the dataset.

2.1. File Format

The Banned and Disqualified Organisations Dataset is provided in a file with the extension of csv (comma separated values), xlsx and tsv.

Note: The Banned and Disqualified Organisations Dataset csv is **not** separated by commas.

The Banned and Disqualified Organisations Dataset csv uses the 'TAB' character as the delimiter (value separator) between values in the dataset; the 'TAB' character is used in place of a comma separator because names can contain commas and therefore are not a suitable delimiter for this dataset. The csv file uses double quote encapsulation around all String datatype variables that contain either a comma (,) or double quote (").


- Dataset Preview on data.gov.au

2.3. File Import into Excel

To import the file to Excel use the following steps:

- 1. Open Excel with a new blank workbook.
- 2. Import data by selecting the 'Data' menu and 'From Text' as the external data source.




3. Choose your file as the data source and select 'Import'.






- 4. Import Wizard:
 - a. Select 'Delimited' as the Original data type then select Next.




b. Select 'Tab' as the Delimiter by checking the box and clear the other check boxes. Then select double quotes " as the Text qualifier and select Next.








c. Select 'General' for Column data format, then select Finish.



5. Put the data into the Existing blank worksheet by entering '=\$A\$1' in the text box. Select OK.

3. Data Dictionary

The Banned and Disqualified Organisations Dataset contains the following fields:

Field	Description	Data Type	Max Length	Data Parameters
REGISTER_NAME	The name of the register the record belongs to.	Text	255	String identifying the register name
BD_ORG_ACN	The Australian Company Number (ACN) of the organisation that has been banned or disqualified.	Numeric	9	Format: 9 digit numerical including leading zeros (e.g. 012345678)
BD_ORG_NAME	The name of the organisation that has been banned or disqualified.	Text	255	As appears on ASIC's register
BD_ORG_TYPE	The type of banning or disqualification that has been applied.	Text	255	As appears on ASIC's register
BD_ORG_URL	The URL link to the supporting documentation.	Text	255	Supporting documentation can include, but is not limited to; - Court Order for ban or disqualification - Information from ASIC's website about the ban or disqualification
				Logic: IF supporting documentation is available THEN show URL link ELSE show "Not Available"
BD_ORG_START_DT	The start date of the ban or disqualification.	Date/Time	10	Date format: DD/MM/YYYY



Field	Description	Data Type	Max Length	Data Parameters
BD_ORG_END_DT	The end date of the ban or disqualification.	Text	255	Dates are formatted in YYYYMMDD
				Logic: IF The ban or disqualification has an end date THEN BD_ORG_END_DT ELSE Null
BD_ORG_COMMENT	Additional information associated with the ban or disqualification.	Text	1000	As appears on ASIC's register
BD_ORG_HTML	The HTML for the URL where applicable.	Text	255	HTML where applicable
