
RMWQMP datasets disclaimer

Under clause 45 (c) of the Murray-Darling Basin Agreement, the Murray-Darling Basin Authority (MDBA) as Authority must establish, maintain, and operate an effective and uniform system for measuring and monitoring the quality of water in:

- River Murray (RM) water
- Water in tributaries of the RM at such locations at or near the confluence of each of those tributaries with the RM as the Authority, after consultation with the appropriate authorities of the Contracting Governments, deems necessary
- Stored water.

The River Murray Water Quality Monitoring Program (RMWQMP) is funded by the MDBA and undertaken by the Contracting Governments of New South Wales, South Australia and Victoria, or their agents.

The RMWQMP dataset includes a suite of physico-chemical and biological parameters related to specific water quality attributes at various locations.
